**Great West Corridor: Local Plan Review:
Regulation 19 Consultation.
Response by The Brentford Community Council.**

1. The BCC has examined the proposal in detail and prepared detail comments set out in our paper BCC 862a, attached.
2. We can summarize our conclusions as follows:
3. As residents, living in Brentford, we consider that this proposal is not a plan to nurture the sustainable expansion of our community, which has a long history and a unique character, but is an opportunist proposal to expand a part of Brentford where land assembly is relatively easy and development is possible, intended to allow the borough to reach expansion targets here that leaves relatively untouched large areas of the borough where multiple freeholds prevail.
4. The targets set for expansion in the Great West Corridor are those which could make a significant contribution to the predicted growth of Greater London, but they risk exceeding a safe relationship between transport improvements and increased densities, risk harming heritage assets and the character of residential Brentford and rely on the availability of funding which is not secure.
