The policy has to be seen in the context of the Government's intention to determine whether additional airport capacity in the South East would be located at Heathrow or elsewhere.

It should also be seen in the light of the Mayor's proposal for a new hub airport in or near the Thames Estuary and his perception that the eventual future for the present airport would be to provide a site for a new community which could have a major impact on the character of west London.

The policy should also be seen in the light of policies EQ 1,4, and 5 as Heathrow contributes directly and by the traffic it attracts to pollution problems.

The Brentford Community Council gave evidence at the Terminal 4 and the Terminal 5 inquiries. Evidence included a survey of Brentford residents which showed overwhelming concern at the environmental damage in our community both when planes overflew Brentford approaching the northern runway and from night flights. Additional pollution problems which have caused concern to our Environmental Health Officer and to the EU arise from traffic



using the A4/M4 corridor to Heathrow.

At both inquiries approval was given to the proposed expansion within limits which were not adhered to.

We have noted that Heathrow is being run to maximise profit and that the operators believe that the airport capacity should be expanded.

It is therefore unsound for the Council to uphold a policy which is based on the impractical belief that Heathrow can remain on its present site without seeking to expand.
