

Minutes of Meeting January 4 2010

1. **Present:** Denis Browne (Chairman) Kath Richardson, Derek Collett, Stephen Browne, Nick MacLean, James Phillips, Matthew Rockel, Andrew Dakers, Lynda Jane James, Chris and Hazel Dakers.
2. The BCC **welcomed** Lynda Jane James as our new treasurer.
3. The BCC noted with regret the death of Dennis Woodman, an active colleague in the Kew Society whose loss was deeply felt.
4. **The minutes of Meeting on November 2009** were approved as a correct record.
5. **Matters Arising: Item 5:** (application adjacent to Chiswick round about. Confirmed that BCC 492 was the view adopted by the BCC.
6. **Presentation:** Application: Clifden Road Swimming Pool proposed conversion of the baths hall. Agreed to support the proposal subject to caveats (see letter to follow)
7. **Albany House** Application: Agreed to ask Matthew Rockel to speak to BCC view at SDC in February that the development should be predominantly at right angles to the river.
8. **Kew Bridge** Deferred application due to go back to SDC. Issues being raised about amount of affordable housing.
9. **SSHS** Andrew reported that the High Street Steering Group and Ballymore were **planning to collaborate with the Princes Foundation for the Built Environment** in a full day **urban design** workshop in February. BCC nominated Kath Richardson, Hazel Dakers and Chris Richards (or Matthew Rockel).
10. Andrew Reported that **Fulcrum** the energy consultant to **ISIS/ Commerce Road site** would be reporting to January 21 IBAC meeting.
11. **London Plan** Consultation: Agreed that joint paper by Denis and Matthew would be sent to the Mayors office. (Letter to follow)
12. Stephen was amending **Thames Landscape Strategy Review** papers on our web to help members access the paper and draft responses.
13. Agreed views on **Minor Applications**. Matthew and Denis to write to LBH.
14. **Brentford Community Strategy:** Kath reported that **she and Stephen** were **presenting the project** and seeking funds from Area Committee January 21.
