

Minutes of meeting: January 20<sup>th</sup> 2010.

1. **Present:** Denis Browne (Chairman, Robert Camlin, Andrew Dakers, Matthew Rockel, Bridget Clements, Stephen Browne, Derek Collett, Linda Jane James, Christopher Richards.
2. **Apologies:** Chris and Hazel Dakers.
3. Jason Debney (co-ordinator) presented the current review of the **Thames Landscape Strategy** adopted in 1994. Documents on BCC web site. He invited comments on all aspects of the document including The Landscape Character Reaches 10, 11 and 12 for Isleworth, Syon and Brentford. Agreed that individuals be asked to reply and that the BCC would draft, amend and adopt a response at our meeting on April 4.
