2. Apologies: Marilyn Baker, John Todd and Hugh Mortimer

2. Minutes of Meeting: August 9 2016. Approved subject to corrections: Layton Road ref is BCC773 Capital Interchange Way is BCC772.

3. Sites in Half Acre and South side High Street: update.

Noted both the Half Acre presentations have been put back to October. Noted Council to debate CPO for SSHS. Attention drawn to 98/99 High Street shop not included in outline planning consent.

4. Capital Interchange Way: Noted applicant's presentation to members only. Q/As attached. Agreed to form sub-committee (Vitas Puig, Derek Collett + Denis in October) to try to promote public meeting (see attached notes).

5. Lionel Road Group: BFC update. Noted Still awaiting info on site start date.

6. Proposal for extending St Pauls CA. Agreed that an extension of the St Pauls CA to South Ealing Road could be pursued. Vitas asked to discuss with LBH Conservation Officer and report back.

7. The Butts/Market Place. noted meeting with LBH officer (attached).

8. Heriage Lighting. Noted the extensive objections (including BCC 746 have resulted in Leader not pursuing Single Member Decision, Decision after further consultation will go to Cabinet.

9. No 5 The Butts: Enforcement. Agreed to ask LBH not to enforce. Chris Richards has confirmed that the Butts Soc support this view.

10. Review of BCC Group Working. Paper by Vitas deferred to October.

11. AOB. Chris Richards reported continuing interest in pedestrian bridge to Kew. Ref to TLS suggested.

Min Sept 2016. Supplementary Notes; Possible Public Meeting to consider the application for development at Capital Interchange Way

1. BCC membership. Vitas Puig, Derek Collett and (after October 1) Denis Browne + Kath Richardson (publicity)

2. Other membership: Peter Eversden, Marie Rabouhans.

3. Objective: To arrange a public meeting which can be attended by members of LBH planning committee and members of wards affected and will attract and inform local residents.

4. Attendance: Ask Bob Whatley (chair of Planning) Mel Collins (chair of IBAF) and Guy Lambert (Local member on planning) for suitable dates. Confirm dates also suitable for Peter Eversden and Marie and any guest speaker (see 6).

5. Select date and book a hall. Possible venues include Watermans, Fountain Centre, Chiswick TH (offered by J Todd) St Pauls Brentford.

6. Decide if guest speaker should be invited. More ideas needed on candidates who will attract interest and focus meeting. Suggestions: David Wetzel (ex TfL leader and LBH leader). Paul Velluet ex EH.

7. Select Chairman. Note we have the active backing of Peter Eversden who successfully chaired our meeting on the Chiswick Curve

8. Invite applicant to present his scheme and take questions.

9. Collect material for projections to illustrate scheme and context.

10. Agree supporting speakers. They should set out the way development on the Golden Mile was being promoted and consented, to look at the merits of this scheme and its implications for further development. note that Marie spoke very effectively at two public meetings on the Curve and that Peter Eversden (Chair of London Forum of Amenity Societies) is fully acquainted with the London Plan and the Mayor's approach to development. The BCC should also put up a speaker.
