4. **Plan First.** Noted for information: BCC785 and BCC 786. Agreed to consider in March how Nick Marbrow's proposal might be shared with other G15+ members
5. **Air Quality Pollution.** Noted BCC 787. Denis reported discussion with the Mayor's officer advising on pollution issues concerned with planning consents including developments on the A4 / M4 corridor.
6. **Capital Interchange Way.** Agreed text of BCC 783 subject to any additional comments to Denis by February 15.
7. **Gillette South:** Noted draft paper from OWGRA. Thanked Paul Velluet for his conservation Paper and noted that he and OWGRA would submit evidence of critical views of Gillette omitted from application papers. Agreed BCC 784 subject to additional comments by February 22.
8. **Waterman's Arts Centre.** noted BCC 782 (attached). In discussion the ward councillors advised that the Leader's discussions with Philip Green were to move Arts Centre to Half Acre with lower housing on river. BCC reinforced its view that the Arts Centre and some lower housing should be gradually redeveloped on the Max Factor / Waterman site.
