### Chairman's Notes.

3. Barratt have instructed John Assael to prepare a revised scheme (after the refusal on appeal) for Albany House and adjacent Goats Wharf. The BCC Statement of Case and proofs are:  
ALB 001, 003, 005, 007, 010 and 015 (see website). The revised scheme will be presented prior to lodging the application.
4. This is a proposed variation to the terrace next to Brent Bridge. We advised on the first scheme before the application was submitted and granted. I have asked the agent to send drawings and clarification.
5. Chris Breslin (ISIS) has sent which is attached summing up his discussions with Brentford residents. These include the need for a Water Based Strategy promoting freight and leisure uses and preserving wharfs for boat construction, repair and servicing.
6. We still do not know the timetable for the pre-application consultation for the Stadium/Griffin Park and the Fountain Centre.
7. The architects are now formally submitting revisions to their 2008 application. We have asked them to arrange a public meeting when they hold their exhibition during the consultation period (expected March/April). We have asked for copies of drawings.
8. We have still no reply from Hounslow to our request that when applications go "on line" on April 1st paper copies of all SDC items should be available. The weekly list is already available on line.
9. Gunnersbury Park report is now out and we hope to have a clear picture of the costs/options and consultation procedure.
