Planning Consultative Committee

1. **Present:** Denis Browne (chairman) James Ansell (Barratts West London) Peter Cadhams (Assael) Simon Pitt (Assael) Cll Andrew Dakers who took no part in decisions being referred to IBAC, John Ormsby (Strand on The Green Assoc) Myra Savin, Stephen Browne (Chair BCC) Heather Jones, Derkek Collett, Matthew Rockel, Hazel and Chris Dakers, Christopher Richards, Malcom Wood (St George's West London and Frances Stansbury (Hounslow Libraries).
2. **Apologies** from Nigel Moore and Matt Harmer.
3. **Minutes** of March 18 agreed as correct record.
4. **Wallis House.** New design for tower-top restaurant presented by Assaels and agreed subject to no increase in height and other reservations (See letter attached)
5. **Wallis House.** 62 additional commercial parking spaces agreed..
6. **Kew Bridge.** After questions taken by Malcolm Wood of St George West London BCC amended/agreed the draft letter.
7. **Alfa Laval.** BCC comments on draft "scoping report" including need to plan for Brentford wide pressures on infra-structure including schools (agreed).
8. **Albany House:** Noted: proposals being reviewed..
9. **South side High Street.** Agreed to respond to Ballymoor's request for informal discussions if they are with their lead members. Derek Collett, Chris Richards, Nigel Moore Denis Browne and Clare Dawson selected.
10. **Stadium:** James Ansell (Barratts West London) said that plans would be revised in May/September period. Noted that BAAP did not commit LBH to stadium but anticipated the development. Concern that plans should not disrupt residents enjoyment of the river nor proceed without a proper urban design/traffic brief (see letter attached).
11. **Potters Arms PH.** Clayponds Lane. Second application rejected BCC to seek listing (See letters attached).
12. **Applications on Line** causing considerable problems. Noted IBAC Monitoring Committee seeking redress. (See letter attached).
- 13 **Brentford Library.** Frances Stanbury (Head of Hounslow Libraries with John Laings) explained recent problems and recruitment/training in hand. BCC (Hazel Dakers/Heather Jones/Denis Browne to write emphasising need to improve service)
