

Minutes for Meeting: May 8 2008 at 7.15.

3. **St George's Church** (former Music Museum) proposed housing scheme. A presentation was given by Jonathan Cross of Crossier Properties Ltd and their architects. They proposed 14 1/3br units within the existing structures. (Letter of BCC comment in document library.)

- 6.0. **Brentford Area Action Plan:** Matthew, Nigel and Denis had attended sessions of the inquiry concerned to determine the "soundness" of LBH plans particularly for individual sites. Special concern for wharf south of High Street, Albany House and Commerce Road. Inspectors report to LBH expected this summer. (See document library for more.)

- 8.0. **Alfa Laval Update.** It is understood that the E/W blocks closing two courts have been removed and the scheme has been set back from Ealing Road. Agreed that Matthew would circulate original BCC comments + draft comments on revisions. Agreed text to go to LBH before SDC in June.
