**School Premises of Floreat Brentford At Trico House.  
Application P/2015/3735**

I have last night received a request from the applicant to support this application in the name of the Brentford Community Council.

The BCC has supported the efforts of Floreat in the context of the present national policy for establishing new schools and would therefore in principal wish to support this application.

***However, the issue of this school provision has been extensively debated at Planning, Cabinet and Scrutiny committees and we therefore consider that this application should be called in for determination by members.***

The BCC welcomed the decision to abandon the proposal to site temporary classrooms at Brent Lea and the wish of many members to ensure that the permanent school was not sited there either.

The BCC would not be confident that the present application was an acceptable part of a co-ordinated programme to provide continuous education for Floreat pupils unless it was supported by a clear commitment by all relevant parties that the permanent school would not be built on Brent Lea. The commitment should ensure that it would be built on an alternative site, which would guarantee that pupils starting with Floreat in 2015 could continue their education in the permanent school buildings.
