The Great West Corridor

The Council is striving to achieve a renaissance of the Great West Corridor. The council has started looking at the issues for the area of the borough extending along the Great West Road, including the area known as the 'Golden Mile', and surrounding areas in Osterley, Brentford and Chiswick. These issues will inform a new plan for the area which will provide a vision for change within the area over the next 15 years. We want to maximise opportunities to build on the area's many strengths including its legacy of major international companies locating here.

How to get involved – public consultation

We need your help to make this change happen. We are consulting on an [Issues paper](#) which gives you an opportunity to shape the content of the plan from the outset. We want to know what you think are the main issues in the Great West Corridor and what we can do about them.

This consultation includes a Call for Sites. This is an opportunity for you to nominate sites for development. These can be for a variety of land uses such as housing, employment or leisure.
