## **19.55-20.25 HOUNSLOW VCS COMMISSIONING AND FUNDING**

### **THERE ARE REALLY IMPORTANT ISSUES FOR FUNDING AND COMMISSIONING OF THE VOLUNTARY SECTOR IN HOUNSLOW SO PLEASE DO ATTEND**

Hounslow Council is planning to make further £160,000 cuts in grants budgets from April 2018. Consultation on draft proposals are due to start from July 2017. Debbie Brenner/Andy Roper to give an update report on the process and key issues

Following a series of strategic meetings by HCN with senior Councillors and Officers the Chair/ Vice Chairs and other VCS reps to report back on:

- Next stages on the Youth Services Review
- Next stages on the review of community buildings- the latest position and requests for information and an HCN meeting with the Council lead officer
- The final new Hounslow External Funding Action Plan

**Stop Press:** On 16 May the Hounslow Cabinet received a report on the youth services review. They have agreed to commission out to the voluntary sector or other providers current in-house Council youth services (other than Hounslow Youth Counselling Service). They will also be holding further meetings with the charities who run three existing Youth Centres

Tenders for commissioned out youth services are likely to open in September. The Council has asked to meet with HCN on 7 June so we will have a lot more update information on the process and timescales at the HCN meeting
