The Planning Consultative Committee of the Brentford Community Council met on September 11 2017 and resolved **to fully endorse the following statements prepared by the West Chiswick and Gunnersbury Society (WCGS):**

And additional comments (2 pages) from WCGS also dated December 2016.

The Brentford Community Council was set up by the London Borough of Hounslow in 1988 as one of a number of Community Councils to comment on

planning and other proposals in their area before these matters were presented to the borough's own Planning Committee.

The Brentford Community Council is now a fully independent Amenity Society which continues to provide local views on development proposals.

Extensive quotations from letters sent to Hounslow Council were included in the officer's report recommending refusals and these letters (BCC759, BCC760 and BCC779) have been forwarded to you.

At para 3 of BCC 779 we listed some of the major developments being put forward for sites close to the appeal site.

The current position (September 2017) is that:

The application for the Capital Interchange Way site is being recommended for refusal,

Preliminary proposals for the B and Q site (called The Hudson Square site) are being put forward without specific regard to the adjacent Chiswick Curve.

These developments reinforce the view taken by the BCC at para 3.04 (BCC779) that the application for the appeal site was premature and should be refused.
